Why should I?



- **First/foremost, because we love Him, and if we love Him we will obey Him!**
- **Because He saved us and our lives are His to command!**
- **Because we have been invited into His fields, and we have work to do!**
- **To do our part to be faithful, fruitful, thereby glorifying God!**

Why should I?



- **Because people need to know, like we did, how He loves us and what He did!**
- ***To give people hope for a good future with an expected end!***
- **To set people free from what they perceive to be their permanent bonds!**
- **To rob the devil of what he thinks will be his eternal spoils!**

What Am I Going to do?



- “Preach the word, be ‘instantly present,’ convenient or not, reprove, rebuke, and exhort with all *longsuffering and doctrine*. The time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine but will find people to say what they want to hear and they will turn away from truth...but you watch, endure afflictions, *do the work of the evangelist*, make full proof of your ministry! *2Timothy 4.2-5*

- “Be sober [lit: nepho] in all situations, bear down on any hardships, ***do the work of the evangelist***, carry out and entirely accomplish your attendance as a servant!” **2Timothy 4.2-5**
- “The work of the *evangelist!*”
 - Building on your relationship with them to bring them to *salvation!*

- “The work of the *evangelist!*”
 - Gaining their ears with the great things God has done, for their *salvation!*

What Am I Going to do?



- “Be sober [lit: nepho] in all situations, bear down on any hardships, ***do the work of the evangelist***, carry out and entirely accomplish your attendance as a servant!” **2Timothy 4.2-5**
- “The work of the *evangelist!*”
 - Using the aspect of your story that is relevant to theirs, for *salvation!*

What Am I Going to do?



- “Be sober [lit: nepho] in all situations, bear down on any hardships, ***do the work of the evangelist***, carry out and entirely accomplish your attendance as a servant!” **2Timothy 4.2-5**
- “The work of the *evangelist!*”
 - Never forgetting the goal is *salvation, and not giving up until it is accomplished!*

What Am I Going to do?



- **Tell a relevant and powerful story of what Jesus has done in your life...**
 - **“To the Jews I spoke like a Jew, to the legalists I spoke of law, to those outside the law I spoke of lawlessness, to the weak I was weak... and I do it all for the gospels sake so that I can be a partaker with you!” 1Cor 9.20-23**
 - ***“I was like that too, and now I am like this because of what He did!”***

Why am I going to do it?



- To give someone a vantage point to see how their lives can be different!
- To expose someone to a different perspective than what they are laboring under!
- To show them a slice of your life so that they can see their own in sharper focus!
- Because people are waiting for something good to happen to them!

Why am I going to do it?



- Because they want you to tell them something powerful and life changing!
- Because they want to hear how *your* “*real*” life was powerfully changed!
 - But speaking clearly to their situations...
 - And respecting their ability to think for themselves!
- To break the hold of the enemy!
- To glorify God!
