You shall consecrate yourselves therefore and be holy...for I the Lord am holy; and I have set you apart from the peoples to be Mine. Lev 20:7-8/23-26

Consecrate

- To set apart, dedicate, or devote irrevocably, to the service and worship of God
- Persons, places, things, and times can be consecrated

Consecration of the Priests

- Ex 29 – Bull / 2 Rams / Bread & Oil
- Purpose: God wanted to meet with and speak to His people
- The presence of God is what consecrates
- What the priests did was to remove the barriers to Him
- 1 Pt 2:5, 9
- Washing – outside the tent / received
- Clothing – not re-clothed
- Sin Offering – hands on the bull altar = PoK
- Burnt Offering – complete/sweet aroma/fire
- Consecration Offering – ear/hand/toe/clothes
- Wave Offering – best / hands filled
Eat remaining = cont. relationship
7 Days / Daily sacrifice – am / pm
- Drink Offering – poured out / sweet aroma

*vs 42-46 I will meet you

2 Tm 2:20, 21

Now in a large house there are not only gold and silver vessels, but also vessels of wood and of earthenware, and some to honor and some to dishonor.

Therefore, if anyone cleanses himself from these things, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified, useful to the Master, prepared for every good work.

Two Parts – Ours & His

- Dedicated vs. Consecrated
- Our Part = separating ourselves from sinful living; repenting
- God's Part = preparing us for His use; making us holy

What do consecrated men look like?

Gideon

- Judges 6 - 8
- Destroyer, Mighty Warrior, Feller of the Trees
- Judge = rendered decisions thru godly wisdom; someone who will bring others into right relationship
- Midian = Strife

2 Cor 4:5-10

For we do not preach ourselves but Christ Jesus as Lord, and ourselves as your bond-servants for Jesus' sake. For God, who said, "Light shall shine out of darkness," is the One who has shone in our hearts to give the Light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ. But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, so that the surpassing greatness of the power will be of God and not from ourselves; *we are afflicted* in every way, but not crushed... perplexed, but not despairing; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed; always carrying about in the body the dying of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body.

1 Cor 1:27-29

God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise...the weak things...to shame the strong...the lowly things...the despised things & the things that are not...so that no one may boast before Him.

God's Math

- Mt 22:14 For many are called but ...few are chosen
- God is calling you to separate
- But your response is critical
- You are chosen when you willingly offer yourself
